It is the applicants' responsibility to clearly show that they meet the minimum qualifications for the position.

**Pay Rate:** Ontario County 2021 Salary Range: \$52,728.00 - \$68,386.50 (\$27.04 - \$35.07/hr)

**Vacancy:** This examination is being held to establish an Eligible List to fill future vacancies in this title, which may occur during the life of the Eligible List. An eligible may receive only one Permanent appointment from this Eligible List. If an eligible accepts a Contingent-Permanent appointment their name will be removed from the Eligible List only for the department or agency in which she/he received the Contingent-Permanent appointment. Once appointed, there will be a probation period of 8 to 26-weeks based on performance of duties.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Immediately preceding the examination date, candidates must possess Permanent Competitive status in the position of Senior Planning Aide for two (2) years in the Ontario County Department of Planning.

**Anticipated Eligibility:** Applicants who lack thirty days, or less, of meeting the minimum qualifications by the date of the examination will be admitted conditionally to the examination. However, proof of the additional days' qualifications must be submitted prior to the establishment of the eligible list.

**Job Description:** This position involves technical work in the review and approval of permits for the construction of County Buildings, as well as inspections during the construction phase. Regular operational inspections of all existing buildings are performed as well as maintenance of records. The work is performed under general supervision of the County Associate Planner with leeway allowed for exercise of independent judgment in carrying out the work. Oversight is exercised over contractors. Does related work as required.

**Subjects of Examination:** A test designed to evaluate knowledge, skills and/or abilities in the following areas:

- 1. Inspection procedures and principles** - These questions test for knowledge of the appropriate practices and methods to use when inspecting various types of building facilities and projects; including proper adherence to plans and codes; dealing with residents, owners, and contractors; and inspection record keeping.
- 2. Building construction and rehabilitation** - These questions test for knowledge of the various methods and materials used when constructing or renovating various types of buildings and their components.
- 3. Understanding and interpreting building plans and requirements** - These questions test for the ability to read, analyze and perform computations based on technical drawings and written technical material related to building facilities and projects. All the information needed to answer the questions will be presented in the written material and/or drawings.

**Subjects of Examination:** (continued)

4. **Understanding and interpreting codes and ordinances** - These questions test for the ability to read and analyze various codes and requirements. Candidates will be provided with written selections related to code provisions (mainly dealing with zoning, housing and property management issues) and will be asked questions based on those reading passages. All the information needed to answer the questions will be presented in the written selections. Candidates will not be required to have any special knowledge related to the content areas covered in the reading selections.

The New York State Department of Civil Service has not prepared a test guide for this examination. However, candidates may find information in the publication 'General Guide to Written Tests' helpful in preparing for this test. Candidates are allowed to use quiet, hand-held, solar or battery powered calculators. Devices with Typewriter Keyboards, Spell Checkers, Personal Digital Assistants, Address Books, Language Translators, Dictionaries, or any similar devices are prohibited. Cell phones, SmartWatches or any similar electronic devices are prohibited. You may not bring books or other reference materials. **You will not be permitted to use the calculator function of your cell phone.**

**SENIORITY CREDITS** (POINTS) WILL BE ADDED TO A SUCCESSFUL ELIGIBLE'S SCORE AS FOLLOWS:

- Less than one year -- 0 points
- 1 year up to 6 years -- 1 point
- Over 6 years up to 11 years -- 2 points
- Over 11 years up to 16 years -- 3 points
- Over 16 years up to 21 years -- 4 points
- Over 21 years up to 26 years -- 5 points

If candidate **fails to receive an admission letter** at least seven days prior to the examination date, you should contact the Department of Human Resources immediately.

Most written tests are held on Saturdays. If you cannot take the test on the announced test date due to a conflict with a religious observance or practice, check the box under **"Religious Accommodation"**. We will make arrangements for you to take the test on a different date (usually the following business day).

**Disabled persons:** If special arrangements for testing are required, indicate this on your application form.

Any member of the **Armed Forces** of the United States of America, who having duly filed an application to compete in a scheduled competitive examination for Civil Service employment by the State of New York or any of its subdivisions and who due to active military duty is deprived of the opportunity to compete in such examination shall be provided with an opportunity to compete, under terms and conditions deemed appropriate by the State Department of Civil Service or Municipal Commission, by way of a special military make-up examination.

**Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program (PSLFP)** - The PSLF Program is intended to encourage individuals to enter and continue to work full-time in public service jobs. Under this program, you may qualify for forgiveness of the remaining balance on your (Direct Loan) loans after you have made 120 qualifying payments on those loans while employed full-time by certain public service employers.
