

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR

THE POSITION

The *Economic Development Director* is a professional and administrative position responsible for implementation and maintenance of the County's Economic Development Plan. This position is responsible for ongoing efforts to position the County as a premier location for economic development in a variety of industry. Primarily responsibility for maintaining and developing collaborative relationships and strategies with the Ontario County Local Development Corporation, local industrial development agencies, County Economic Development Corporation, existing businesses, and the Finger Lakes Visitor Connection. This position assists the towns and cities in attracting industries, determining locations, and assisting existing industries with expansion. Must be able to effectively administer programs and produce measurable results.

Starting Salary for 2022: \$107,775 dependent on experience, with comprehensive benefits package including 2% match to deferred compensation, full health and dental insurance, wellness program, EAP, professional development training, and NYS Retirement pension.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Possession of a Bachelor's Degree AND four (4) years of full-time paid experience, or its part-time equivalent, in economic development, public administration, business management, business development, sales, marketing or other field related to industrial and/or economic development. Preference for at least two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity. A lower level degree will be accepted with additional years of described experience.

Ontario County residency required within 12 months of appointment.
