MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AS SHOWN ON JOB DESCRIPTION

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must be at least *16 years of age.

REQUIREMENTS AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT:

- 1) Possession of a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate received from an acceptable agency listed in the Aquatic Certifications for NYS Bathing Facilities fact sheet produced by the NYS Department of Health; AND
- 2) Possession of a current Lifeguard Training Certificate, or (for pools only) a certificate in Basic Lifeguarding from an agency acceptable by the NYS Department of Health (such as the American Red Cross, Boy Scouts, YMCA).

WATERFRONT LIFEGUARDING also requires: American Red Cross Lifeguard Waterfront Module.

* NOTE: May be 15 years of age if employed at a facility where a Senior Lifeguard is present.

<u>NOTE</u>: The New York State Department of Health requires CPR Certificates renewed annually for Lifeguarding positions, regardless of the expiration date on the card.

HOW TO APPLY: All applications must be received through the <u>Ontario County Civil Service</u> Employment Portal.
