Directs all financial activities of the City, including general accounting, budget preparation & oversight, debt management, utility and property tax billing, cash investment management and support City's labor negotiations; Responsible for the financial integrity of the fiscal records of all City Funds and accounts, including all capital projects. Supervises staff of four (4) and reports to City Manager.
