

## LABORER

Minimum Qualifications: None

Preferred: High School Diploma or General Equivalency Diploma, New York State Drivers License

Education/Training: Employee must be able to successfully complete New York State Water Operator course (Class D) within one year of hire date.

Job Summary: This position involves operating equipment and performing manual labor to participate in the completion of assigned projects. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Public Works Supervisor.

Essential Duties: The following duties are normal for this job. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Maintenance of village roadways; this includes patching, spreading stone, building up gravel on shoulders, plowing, laying salt and reporting needed repairs to the DPW Supervisor.
- Mowing and weed-whipping village property.
- Collects household waste, yard waste, brush.
- Operation and maintenance of village water and waste water systems.
- Maintains and repairs to village buildings and grounds.
- Maintains vehicles and equipment.
- Performs general building and grounds cleaning tasks.

Full performance knowledge, skills, abilities and personal characteristics: Willingness to perform routine manual work; ability to lift heavy weights; willingness to work under all weather conditions; physical endurance; sobriety; willingness to work occasional overtime; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
