MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- 3. An equivalent combination of training and experience as described in (1) and (2) above.

FEATURES OF THE POSITION: This position assists professional staff in a variety of assignments. The specific duties will vary according to the assigned program area, though most will involve significant contact with the public. Duties may include determination and verification of eligibility for programs/services, assisting clients in accessing and providing supportive services.
