SUPERVISING SOCIAL WORKER (COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is professional and administrative work involving responsibility for administering and supervising the social work and mental health services of a community mental health program and clinic. The work includes wide responsibility for independent action and programming and involves the oversite and instruction of subordinate social workers. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Participates in the intake and screening of new patients (making an evaluation in all areas medical);

- Participates as a clinic team member, providing mental health, social work, or psychological expertise,
- to assist in assessing and diagnosing patients and planning for their treatment;
- Participates as a clinic team member in conferences designed for diagnosis of the mental health treatment of patients;
- Participates in informational and educational community activities to further community knowledge and the prevention of mental health disorders;
- Participates in team visits in clinic, patients' homes, and school-based settings;
- Works with other professionals and paraprofessionals in exploring the community to find individuals who need treatment but are unable or unwilling to seek treatment;
- Participates in long range planning toward the development of better mental health programs;
- Participates in campaigns to stimulate interest in the prevention and detection of mental illness including storefront collaboration with other social services, schools, home visiting, family programs, aftercare and referral systems in participation with other professionals and paraprofessionals;
- Refers cases to other agencies and coordinates various activities and treatment programs with other governmental and non-governmental social agencies;
- May direct in-service training of other professionals and paraprofessionals, relating to the contributions that mental health care can give to an interdisciplinary treatment team.
