Duties will include assisting our health educators with presentations, health fairs, and other community events; working on targeted health-promotion project(s); gathering data; and networking with existing staff and community partners.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Completion of one (1) year of college study from a college or university with a major in business, engineering, finance, marketing, planning, public administration, human resources, nursing, criminal justice, statistics, or a closely related field AND must be currently enrolled full-time in an accredited college degree program at time of application.
