QUALIFICATIONS:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Two (2) years of full-time paid experience, or its part-time equivalent, in the operation of heavy, single unit trucks and other heavy equipment used in the construction industry.

SUBSTITUTION - EXPERIENCE: Possession of vocational or technical certification, or higher, in Heavy Equipment Operation or Diesel Technology/Power Mechanics may substitute for the one (1) year of paid experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT - AT TIME OF APPLICATION: Possession of a valid Class B New York State Commercial Driver's License with no restrictions at the time of application, and maintenance of such license throughout the tenure of employment in the position.

MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II

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DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Employees in this class perform public work activities/duties involving operation of heavy construction equipment including trucks requiring a Commercial Driver's License Class B. This class does not involve driving a semi-tractor trailer except on a training or fill-in basis. This class differs from the Motor Equipment Operator I due to the more complex nature of equipment operated requiring greater skill along with increased responsibility for safety of others. Minimal supervisory work is required and is generally limited to laborers, wing operators or MEO I position. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Operates motor equipment such as: double axle dump trucks (may have snow removal equipment attached), tractors, wrecker, high pressure street flusher, tilt trailer, front end loaders, recycling balers, bulldozers, backhoes, rollers, compressors, sewer cleaners, street sweepers and other types of equipment classified as heavy and medium duty used in the construction and maintenance of highways and other public works projects; Performs routine upkeep maintenance (check fluids, lights, belts, tires, etc.) on assigned equipment; Occasionally tows trailers rated at less than 10,000 lbs. Gross Vehicle Weight Rating; Cuts trees, weeds and bushes, does manual road patching and traffic flagging in connection with highway maintenance; Assists with the setting of guardrails and posts; Performs a variety of manual tasks; Cleans and services equipment; May participate in snowplowing and snow removal; May, on assignment, operate other types of automotive equipment.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the operation of assigned construction and snow removal equipment and other equipment classified; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; willingness to respond to emergencies and perform overtime work; willingness to work in adverse weather conditions; mechanical aptitude; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
