An employee in this class is responsible for personally performing the more technical and skilled maintenance duties and for leading and participating in the performance of less skilled activities. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Chief Sewage Treatment Plant Operator, Type B, who schedules and prioritizes assignments and inspects the work performed. Does related work as required.
